Description of work done

Water leak discovered on commercial water line on Cty Rte 119 near area where previous leak was repaired on 9/18/18 (work order #1112). Dug out with backhoe and found leak at bell joint. Could not repair the way we wanted to because the pipe was laying directly on bedrock and we were unable to jackhammer through the bedrock enough to place a bell joint clamp around the pipe. We sealed leak with pipe sealant and poured (5) bags of concrete around bell joint to further seal. Backfilled with sand first and then dirt.

Engine on Hi-Way Super P stainless steel gas powered sander partially siezed up. Took apart and discovered broken exhaust valve as the problem. This engine is 13 years old and it was decided to order a new one due to the corrosion and wear and tear that it will endure and cost of parts to repair old engine will be roughly half the cost of new. Installed new engine. It is slightly different from old engine and some retrofitting to engine mounts and rewiring was necessary for installation and proper operation.

Description of work done

Sewer manhole on Main St in front of Cosmos at the end of Center St was caving in. We came in at midnight to avoid heavy traffic while we repaired it. Jackhammered out manhole ring and replaced top 2 layers of damaged bricks with 2 layers of new bricks. We then put the ring back into place and poured concrete around the ring. Backfilled with cold patch, tamped level to street.

Throughout month Continued to pick up yard debris and leaves until weather will not allow us to continue. This has been a difficult process with wet weather. The leaf picker would continue to plug with wet leaves and we also had 2

snow storms in mid November to contend with. We are continuing our efforts to get as many leaves as possible.
