Repaired hydraulic drive spline mount of village backhoe and hydraulic hose fittings of rear bucket. Installed all new belts and hoses as a part of spline repair.

Installed new pivot mount on street sweeper vacuum line, ordered and installed new hydraulic lines for sweeper. Repaired spray nozzles and replaced brushes on front.

Sweeper used to clean storm drains on New Street, Ann Street, Kingsbury, Crouse Blvd and Lion Ave a total of thirteen storm drains. Estimated 100 total village storm drains in Village.

Weld repairs for deck and handles of merry-go-round and mixed and poured concrete for the foundation. Installed Merry Go Round at park and mulched around base.

Remove tree trunks and limbs to yard and chip all debris for tree removed by Nat Grid on Averil.

Paint top of pole barn and garage door. Repair fence between salt barn and pole barn and moved unsightly dumpster to rear of building.

Repair all wiring in Pavilion and installed used fridge.

Painted yellow dividing lines on Timmerman and Averil.

Installed new brake lines in flatbed.

Built remaining picnic tables needed for Marina.

Diagnosed problem with compressor at fire house and ordered pressure switch, fixed flag pole lights.

WASTEWATER PLANT BOARD REPORT

June-July 2018

Daily Operations: Process control collect samples from plants influent and effluent water flow from village and test and record data from P.H., temperature and suspended solids levels. Then collect samples of activated sludge from the plants aerator and clarifier. Test and record P.H. level, temperature and the sludges settleability in clarifier. Calculate flow levels and wasting rates, microscopic observation of sludge quality and age. Clean aerator rake of solids, inspect and record hours for influent pump lift station, blowers for aeration system and clarifier. Inspect sump pumps in basement and measure the sludge blanket.

Weekly Operations: Brush algae from clarifier weir plate and chlorinate. Empty buckets of solids from aerator rake and barrels from barscreen. Hose down barscreen building floors upstairs and down, keep tray clean of solids, exercise by-pass gate and keep screen clear. Clean electrodes, keep filters and solenoids clear of debris on vacuum primer pump system. Run grit washer and dispose in dumpster when needed, keep troughs clean of scum build up. Mow grounds and weed eat fence line and garbage disposal when needed. Collect and prepare samples for laboratory analysis for B.O.D., TSS and fecal coliform levels to be reported to DEC and EPA.

Plants operational activities: Digester sludge pump out and hauled to Johnstown Gloversville Joint Wastewater treatment plant

Enrolled Mike Kardash at SUNY Morrisville's Environmental Training Center. Class begins July 23 and runs thru August 3, 2018. For basic operations of a wastewater treatment plant.

Pressure washed and then painted grit chamber platform and the same on the influent pump lift station vault.

Laboratory scale cleaned and calibrated by All-State scale.

Installed re-built R.A.S #2 pump and tray

Repacked coupling on barscreen rake motor

Purchased 4'' trash pump from Northern Safety and Industrial

Drained and cleaned clarifier #2. Inspected frame work

Rebuilt skimmer on Clarifier #1

Built platform for 4'' pump to set on for digester pump out.

Pressure wash algae off concrete walls on the aerator and parshell flume

Mowed lawns and weed eat fence line around plant and new bathrooms
